West Fork Water and Wastewater Commission Minutes January 16, 2013

The West Fork Water and Wastewater Commission met Wednesday January 16, 2013 at the city administration building for a regular meeting.

Members present: Mr. Virgil Blackmon, Mr. Andy Baughman, and Mr. Frank Adams Members absent: Mr. Mike Mitchell and Mr. Joe Toher

- 1. Meeting was called to order by Mr. Blackmon at 12:00pm. Mr. Blackmon verified that the press had been notified.
- 2. Minutes of the December 12, 2012 meeting were reviewed- Mr. Baughman made a motion to approve the minutes seconded by Mr. Adams, all voted for.
- 3. The commission reviewed the systems total report
- 4. The commission reviewed the income statement. The Water Department ended 2012 \$72,169.06 under budget.
- 5. Commission reviewed the 2011 Water and Wastewater Audit.
- 6. The commission reviewed line repairs for 2012.
- 7. Update on the wastewater project
 - a. Commission reviewed a letter from Water and Wastewater funding agency- everything is in order and we can apply for funding.
 - b. Mr. White, from McClelland Engineers, told the commission of three funding options:
 - 1. Arkansas Natural Resources General Obligation Bond- 30 year loan at 4% interest, takes 6 to 9 months to complete the process.
 - 2. Arkansas Natural Resources EPA program- 20 year loan at 1.9% interest, takes 9 to 12 months to complete the process.
 - 3. USDA Rural Development- which does not have significant funds for the entire project.

Mr. Adams made a motion seconded by Mr. Baughman to approve the application process for the Arkansas Natural Resources General Obligation Bond, all voted for.

- c. Commission reviewed the ARNC bond application process and requirements.
- d. Mr. Adams made a motion seconded by Mr. Baughman that Stephens Inc. will be asked to serve as bond council on the wastewater project, all voted for.
- e. Commission reviewed the City of Fayetteville's resolution to provide West Fork wholesale wastewater service.
- f. Commission reviewed preliminary plans for location of new wastewater line.
- g. Commission was informed that penalties or fines could be assessed if project is not completed in a 3 year time period.
- 8. Commission reviewed thank you letters sent to Cassi Boyd and Mike Nelson
