

## West Fork Water and Wastewater Commission Minutes November 7, 2012

The West Fork Water and Wastewater Commission met Wednesday November 7, 2012 at the city administration building for a regular meeting.

Members present: Mr. Virgil Blackmon, Mr. Andy Baughman, Mr. Frank Adams, and Mr. Mike Mitchell

Members absent: Mr. Joe Toher

Also present: Mr. Bartholomew, Mr. Robert White, Ms. Drymon, Steve Winkler, Fred Robinson, Paula Caudle, Bobbi Henington, Mike Nelson, Charlie Rossetti, and Ed Stout.

- 1. Meeting was called to order by Mr. Blackmon at 12:00p.m.
- 2. Chairman Blackmon verified that the press had been notified of the meeting.
- 3. Chairman Blackmon discussed the vote to dissolve the commission, and stated that the commission would continue business as usual until further action from the city council.
- 4. Minutes of the October 3, 2012 meeting were reviewed. Mr. Baughman made a motion to approve the minutes seconded by Mr. Mitchell, all voted for.
- 5. Commission reviewed the systems total report for October.
- 6. Commission received and reviewed an estimated time-line for the sewer line connection to the City of Fayetteville.
- 7. Commission received a copy of a letter regarding engineering surveying done for sewer project.
- 8. Commission received a copy of a letter to ADEQ addressing concerns of non-compliance during the construction period.
- 9. Mr. White, McClelland's Engineering, reported that there has been progress made on surveying between West Fork and Greenland.
- 10. The commission received a letter of resignation from Mrs. Cassi Boyd. Motion to accept Mrs. Boyd's resignation was made by Mr. Mitchell seconded by Mr. Baughman, all voted for. The commission asked that a letter of thanks and appreciation be drafted for Mrs. Boyd.
- 11. The commission was asked to approve the 2013 operating budget. Motion to approve the budget was made by Mr. Adams seconded by Mr. Baughman, all voted for.
- 12. Mr. Bartholomew informed the commission that West Fork Water Utility would be losing their biggest customer, Washington Water Authority, sometime in 2013.
